

Three Positions Available to Serve on the Cache Creek Landfill Extension Monitoring Committee

Belcorp Environmental Services Inc. and the Village of Cache Creek jointly hold the Operational Certificate for the Cache Creek Landfill Extension (the Extension). Applications are being sought from community members interested in serving on the landfill Monitoring Committee for a two-year term.

The purpose of the Monitoring Committee is to:

- Provide a communication forum between the Operational Certificate Holders and local communities;
- Receive updates on site development, operations, closure activities, post-closure activities and on-going environmental monitoring / interpretation;
- promote environmentally sound operations and effective monitoring; and
- Identify emerging issues and new information relevant to operation of the Extension

The Monitoring Committee will consist of seven members, including one representative each from the Villages of Cache Creek and Ashcroft, Bonaparte Indian Band, Ashcroft Indian Band in addition to three members from the community at large.

Members of the community at large must satisfy the following eligibility criteria:

1. Have their primary residence situated within 20 kilometers of the Extension or be registered members of the Bonaparte or Ashcroft Indian Bands;
2. Have prepared a Statement of Interest in landfill operations that has been favourably reviewed by the Committee; and
3. Have the ability to attend all Monitoring Committee meetings.

The Monitoring Committee meetings will be held quarterly. Compensation will be made to community members for their participation. Compensation will be limited to \$50 per meeting.
